Sheena Warman is a Senior Clinical Fellow in Small Animal Medicine at the University of Bristol in the UK. She spent 4 years in mixed practice before undertaking a residency in Small Animal Medicine and Intensive Care at the University of Bristol, and gained RCVS and ECVIM Diplomas in Small Animal Medicine in 2004. After a short time in private referral practice she returned to join the medicine team at the University of Bristol. Sheena has wide ranging clinical interests in canine medicine, and is a co-editor of "100 Top Consultations in Small Animal Practice".
