# Reptile health, husbandry, therapeutics and treatment

Let the scales fall from your eyes in this talk on common problems seen in snakes, lizards, tortoises and turtles.



Bairbre O'Malley graduated from UCD in 1984. She spent 3 years working in small animal practice in the UK and two years in Australia. Following that she spent 9 years working at an RSPCA emergency hospital in London with a 40 % caseload in wildlife and exotics. In 1990 she became lecturer in Exotic Species at the Royal Veterinary College, UK. In 1991 she returned to Ireland where she became Associate Lecturer in Exotic species at the Veterinary College, Dublin. In 2002 she set up the first veterinary hospital in Ireland specialising in exotic pets where she sees first opinion and referral exotic cases. Her veterinary textbook 'Clinical anatomy and physiology of exotic species' sells worldwide. She has lectured on exotics at WSAVA Dublin 2008, WSAVA Korea 2011 and FECAVA 2013.
