A few points to note:

Shanes Castle Estates have been extremely generous giving us access to areas of this beautiful estate seldom seen by the public. Please keep this is mind on the day and obey the rules below to ensure everyone has a safe and enjoyable day!

- ⇒ Let us know that you are coming! We need to ensure we have enough food for everyone.
- ⇒ Please access the estate from the entrance off the A6, Castle Road (between Junction with M22 and Antrim) opposite the Maghereagh Road. Once through this entrance you will see signage directing you to the Welcome Desk, BBQ site and starting point for the walks.
- ⇒ Please come to the Welcome Desk on arrival for this event and collect a map with marked walk routes. The long walk route is approx. 6 miles and takes in lough shore, garden, forest, pasture, river bank and parkland. The shorter route approx. 2.5miles and includes lough shore, garden and parkland.
- ⇒ Shane's Castle is a working estate and farm. For this event, dogs are very welcome but as a condition of our having access, they must be **kept on leads at all times.**
- \Rightarrow Poop bags will be provided for the dogs. There are toilets for everyone else \odot
- ⇒ Walkers please wear suitable footwear.
- ⇒ We have "requested" a gorgeous day and there is plenty of cover whilst BBQ-ing but this is NI so please remember to bring a rain coat if you are planning on following the walks!
