## The Food Standards Agency - what's it all about?

...and what on earth is a vet doing there?

Following studies at Glasgow Vet School, Kirsten's early years in practice were varied with spells in both equine and small animal practice. She joined DAERA (or DANI as it was known then) in 1992 where her duties have included inspecting riding schools, teaching on the equine courses at Enniskillen, working in red meat abattoirs, working on identification, registration and movement and finally as acting DVO, Zoonoses.

The opportunity came up to be seconded to the newly formed Food Standards Agency (FSA) in 2000. Kirsten moved permanently from the Department to the FSA in 2003 and she now heads up a couple of teams, one of which looks after DAERA and the work they do on FSA's behalf and the other which liaises with District Councils.

Her other key role is as the lead for the FSA NI on EU Exit.
