## Motivational Interviewing

or how to get your clients (and kids) to do what you want! with

## Owen Atkinson

Having excellent knowledge simply isn't good enough to be an effective vet. We also need to be able to communicate well. In order to achieve behavioural change, the communication required is far more complex than knowledge exchange. Owen will relay some of his own journey in learning to be a better communicator and facilitator of behavioural change. This began with a Nuffield travel scholarship in 2010, and is still very much work in progress.

An **introductory presentation** will outline some theoretical models of behavioural change and the philosophy behind Motivational Interviewing (MI). MI has been demonstrated to show much promise in fields of human medicine and addiction counselling.

A **short interactive session** to follow will allow participants to practice some Motivational Interviewing skills with each other.

The meeting will provoke thought, will be fun and will provide some top tips that most attendees should find novel and useful. It might even change some behaviours!

Lessons learnt can be applied in all areas of practice and are suitable for many team members—vets, nurses, reception staff

Think: - Weight loss clinics for companion animals

- Herd health plan compliance
- Responsible use of antibiotics
- Conversations surrounding breeding of brachycephalic dogs
- Vaccination compliance
- Euthanasia decision making
