Multimodal management for OA is often held up as the gold standard for treatment.

It is useful for formulating strategies to deal with difficult cases, but it is also an essential approach for implementing and delivering successful sustained

management of OA cases.

The Problem: It is very easy to talk about but much more difficult to deliver in practice

We will discuss a process which solves this. What is this?

- 1. A case assessment that is made with multimodal decisions in mind
- 2. A simple scheme to place every case into a general management group that helps the pet owner understand the aim of management
- 3. A grid-based system to select the different management component that are appropriate to an individual case
- 4. How to assemble a Practice Tool-box for multimodal management
- 5. How to create 5 point-plans that are simple, flexible yet focused on delivering a workable plan for the practice; client and patient

Using a process for your arthritis cases makes delivery of comprehensive multimodal management a reality and makes for a much more contextualised and holistic approach to solve immediate clinical problems and sustain treatment over the entire course of the disease.
